**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE SUPPRESSION MOTION**

Comes the defendant, by counsel, and moves the Court pursuant to LR6(A)(3) to extend the time within which he is to file suppression motions herein to and including October 7, 2008. As grounds, the defense notes that certain pre-trial motions, including motions to suppress, were due on October 3, 2008. In discussing this deadline with the United States, it was the defense's understanding that the government was going to make a joint motion asking the Court to extend the October 3 deadline for filing motions. However, the government filed a request for an extension only for itself. The defense then filed a motion to suppress yesterday, October 7, 2008.
