ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the motion of the United States for an extension of time in which to file pretrial motions related to discovery issues, admissibility of the evidence, and further neuropsychological testing or examination of the Defendant. The United States has also requested that the Court enter an order directing the disclosure, no later than December 1, 2008, of all materials upon which Defendant's expert witnesses have relied to form the basis of their opinions, including all medical records, test instruments, responses, and other raw test data or results.

The Court having considered the motion, and being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion of the United States be and it is hereby GRANTED.

The deadline for the filing of pretrial motions related to the discovery issues, admissibility, and further testing or examination of the Defendant in connection with mental health evidence he has given notice he intends to introduce during the guilt phase of this trial, be and it is hereby extended to December 31, 2008.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant disclose to the United States, on or before December 1, 2008, all materials upon which Defendant's expert witnesses may rely to form the basis of their opinions, including all medical records, test instruments, responses, and other raw test data.
