UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO UNSEAL
CERTAIN GRAND JURY RELATED PLEADINGS


Comes the United States of America, by counsel, and respectfully moves the Court to unseal certain pleadings related to grand jury matters previously filed in this case. In support of its motion, the United States submits that it is filing, contemporaneously with this motion and under seal, the United States' Response and Objection to Defendant's Motion for Dismissal of the Indictment, Grand Jury Related Discovery, and Appropriate Sanctions. Defendant's Motion for Dismissal of the Indictment, filed on January 19, 2007, refers to (i) a motion to quash grand jury subpoenas compelling the testimony of Green's family members; (ii) a supplemental motion to quash; (iii) the response of the United States' to Defendant's Motion to Quash; and (iv) the Court's Memorandum Opinion and Order of October 30, 2006, denying the Defendant's motions to quash. Each of these documents had previously been ordered filed under seal, *sua sponte*, pursuant to the Court's direction, as a matter related to the grand jury. By referring to the subpoenas to Green's family members, and the ensuing pleadings arising from Green's efforts to

quash them, and without seeking to have the seal lifted, Green's counsel have acted in breach of the seal, and apparently abandoned any belief that the Court's seal should be maintained.


The United States cannot respond to Defendant's Motion for Dismissal of the Indictment without referring to matters contained within those pleadings referenced above which remain under seal. In an abundance of caution, the United States is filing its Response and Objection to Defendant's Motion for Dismissal of the Indictment under seal, and tenders an Order with this motion asking the Court to unseal the pleadings and the Court's Order related to Green's motions to quash, and to unseal simultaneously the United States' Response to Defendant's Motion for Dismissal of the Indictment. The undersigned has conferred with Scott T. Wendelsdorf, Federal Public Defender, counsel for Defendant Green, who has authorized the United States to advise the Court that he has no objection to this motion.
