

Notice Re: Entry into Western District Courthouses Effective March 16, 2020

The Centers for Disease Control having advised people to take precautions in light of the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus) outbreak, the following individuals SHOULD NOT ENTER THE COURTHOUSE:

- Persons who have been diagnosed with or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with coronavirus (COVID-19)
- Persons with a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, flu-like symptoms, or other symptoms of respiratory illness
- Persons who have traveled to the countries of China, Italy, Iran, Japan, or South Korea in the past 14 days, or have come into close contact with anyone who has traveled to those countries within the past 14 days
- Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any health care provider or agency

If you are scheduled or required to appear at this Courthouse (or otherwise need to visit offices in the building), and you are unable to enter because of these restrictions, please proceed as follows:
