Explanation and Instructions-Read Carefully

(1) You may use this form if you are a pre-trial detainee challenging your pre-conviction custody, a federal prisoner challenging the execution of your sentence or actions taken by the Bureau of Prisons, an immigration detainee challenging your detention, or in other situations where relief is not available under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 or 28 U.S.C. § 2255.

If you are challenging the constitutionality of your state-court conviction or sentence, you must file a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

If you are a federal prisoner attacking the legality of your federal conviction or sentence, you must file a motion to vacate, set aside or correct sentence pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255, unless a § 2255 motion is inadequate or ineffective to test the legality of your detention. If you believe this is the case, you must explain why in the appropriate section of the § 2241 form.

- (2) The petition must: (1) specify all the grounds for relief available to you; (2) state the facts supporting each ground; (3) state the relief requested; (4) be printed, typewritten, or legibly handwritten; and (5) be signed under penalty of perjury by you or by a person authorized to sign it for you.
- (3) Additional pages are not permitted except with respect to the facts upon which you rely to support your grounds for relief. Do not make legal arguments or cite cases or statutes. However, identify the constitutional right(s) you allege was/were violated. If briefs or arguments are submitted, they should be submitted in the form of a separate memorandum.
- (4) You must submit a \$5 filing fee when you file your petition. If you cannot afford the filing fee, you may file an application to proceed without prepayment of filing fees, setting forth information establishing your inability to pay. You must have an authorized officer at your penal institution complete the certificate as to the amount of money and securities on deposit to your institutional account.
- (5) The petition must name as respondent the warden, jailer, or other authorized person having custody of you.

(6) To file the petition with the Court, mail the fully completed original to the Clerk of the United States District Court. **Keep a copy of the petition for your records.** The Clerk's Office mailing addresses are:

. AMENDED NOTICE OF ELECTRONIC AVAILABILITY OF CIVIL CASE FILE INFORMATION

(AMENDED TO COMPLY WITH THE AUGUST 2, 2004 AMENDMENTS TO THE E-GOVERNMENT ACT OF 2002)

The United States District Courts for the Eastern and Western Districts of Kentucky are making the content of documents filed in electronic form or converted from a paper filing to electronic form available on the court's Internet web site via WebPACER. Any subscriber to WebPACER will be able to read, download, store and print the full content of electronically filed or electronically converted documents. The clerk's office will not make available over the Internet electronic documents that have been sealed or otherwise restricted by court order.

You should not include sensitive information in any document filed with the court unless such inclusion is necessary and relevant to the case. Any personal information not otherwise protected will be made available over the Internet via WebPACER. If sensitive information must be included, the following personal identifiers must be partially redacted from the document, whether it is filed on paper or electronically:

- A. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS. If an individual's social security number must be included in a document, only the last four digits of that number should be used.
- B. NAMES OF MINOR CHILDREN. If the involvement of a minor child must be mentioned, only the initials of that child should be used.
- C. DATES OF BIRTH. If an individual's date of birth must be included in a document, only the year should be used.
- D. FINANCIAL ACCOUNT NUMBERS. If financial account numbers are relevant, only the last four digits of these numbers should be used.

In compliance with the E-Government Act of 2002, and as amended August 2, 2004, a party filing a document containing any of the personal data identifiers specified above may:

(a) file an unredacted copy under seal. This document shall be retained by the court as part of the record. A redacted copy for the public record must be filed along with the unredacted document under seal. OR

Reference Electronic Case Filing Administrative Policies and Procedures for the Eastern and Western Districts of Kentucky

(b) file a reference list under seal. The reference list shall contain the complete personal data identifier(s) and the redacted identifier(s) used in its (their) place in the filing. All references in the case to the redacted identifiers included in the reference list will be construed to refer to the corresponding complete identifier. The reference list must be filed under seal, and may be amended as of right. It shall be retained by the court as part of the record.

The Court recognizes that parties may need to include in the record a document containing information such as any personal identifying number such as a driver's license number; medical records, treatment and diagnosis; employment history; individual financial information; and proprietary or trade secret information. Technical and administrative procedures to effectuate the filing of these documents along with other important information can be found in the Court's Electronic Case Filing Administrative Policies and Procedures (Reference Number 15.2) and the User Manual. The Court's Electronic Case Filing Administrative Policies and Procedures and the Court's User Manuals are available through the Courts' web sites at www.kywd.uscourts.gov and www.kywd.uscourts.gov, or can be obtained from any Division of the Court.

Counsel is strongly urged to share this notice with all clients so that an informed decision about the inclusion of certain materials may be made. It is the sole responsibility of counsel and the parties to be sure that all pleadings and other papers comply with the rules of this court requiring reduction of personal data identifiers.
