**GENERAL ORDER
NO. 22-09**


During the year preceding the expiration of his term, Magistrate Judge Colin H. Lindsay expressed a willingness to be reappointed as a United States Magistrate Judge. In response, the District Judges of this Court unanimously voted to consider his reappointment pursuant to the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing the Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges. Among the requirements stated therein is that public notice soliciting public comment on the incumbent's performance be issued and that a Merit Selection Panel be convened to assist the Court in reviewing his performance.

On April 29, 2022, the Court appointed a Merit Selection Panel, chaired by the Honorable Mark S. Riddle of Louisville, Kentucky. The Court published the requisite public notice through the local newspaper, bar association newsletters, and on its public internet site. The Court additionally sent electronic notice to all lawyers registered with the Court's electronic case filing system, CM/ECF.

After due consideration of public comment and following an interview with Judge Lindsay, the Merit Selection Panel recommended his reappointment. The District Judges having unanimously voted to reappoint Judge Lindsay to another eight-year term,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that United States Magistrate Judge Colin H. Lindsay is reappointed for a term of eight years effective December 30, 2022. The Clerk of Court shall cause a copy of this Order to be sent to the Judicial Services Office of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts along with the duly executed AO Form 79A.
