**AMENDMENT TO GENERAL ORDER HOLDING IN ABEYANCE  
CIVIL MATTERS INVOLVING THE UNITED STATES AS A PARTY**

On October 1, 2025, the Court entered General Order No. 25-13 due to the lapse of congressional appropriations funding the federal government, including the Department of Justice and the United States Attorney's Office for the Western District of Kentucky. The Court amended General Order No. 25-13 on October 15, 2025.

The United States Attorney's Office for the Western District of Kentucky has informed the Court that Congress has appropriated funding for that Office and that as of November 13, 2025, its attorneys and employees have resumed their duties in normal fashion.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the stay imposed by General Order No. 25-13, as amended, is hereby lifted. All deadlines in civil cases affected by General Order No. 25-13, as amended, shall be extended for 43 days or as otherwise directed by the judge overseeing the case.

The Court shall distribute this amendment to General Order No. 25-13:

- (a) by electronic service to all registered CM/ECF users; and
- (b) by posting the General Order No. 25-13 and this amendment on the Court's public website.

Any litigant affected by General Order No. 25-13, as amended, may seek relief from the order by motion. The Court may, in any particular case, vary the effect or operation of this General Order by a separate ruling.
