
GENERAL ORDER No. 2012-10

IN RE: ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO PRESENTENCE REPORTS

Effective October 1, 2012, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the United States Probation Office for the Western District of Kentucky (the Probation Office) shall file all presentence investigation reports it prepares electronically under seal through the Case Management/Electronic Case Filing System (CM/ECF). Upon electronically filing its presentence investigation reports, and unless otherwise ordered by the Court, the Probation Office shall disclose said reports to the defendant's attorney and to the designated Assistant United States Attorney, each of whom shall be granted access to view such presentence investigation reports electronically through CM/ECF. The Probation Office shall mail copies of its presentence investigation reports to any defendants proceeding *pro se* and to any defense attorneys who are not registered CM/ECF participants.

This order shall supersede Joint General Order 11-02 to the extent that Joint General Order 11-02 provides that sealed documents will be electronically accessible only to the Court.
