GENERAL ORDER NO. 2014-07

IN RE: **HOUSING AND RELEASE OF DUI PRISONERS FROM LAND BETWEEN THE  
LAKES AND MAMMOTH CAVE**

This Order addresses procedures for the housing and release of federal arrestees in custody on charges of public intoxication and driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled substances arising in the Land Between The Lakes National Recreation Area within the Paducah division of the United States District Court for the Western District of Kentucky and in the Mammoth Cave National Park within the Bowling Green division. This Order applies only to arrestees who have entered a waiver of an appearance without unnecessary delay before a judge pursuant to Fed.R.Crim.P. 5 and agreement to appear voluntarily in court at a later date.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Jailer, Deputy Jailers, and any authorized employees of any jail in this judicial district that is authorized to house federal prisoners are authorized, without further order of court, to hold any prisoners apprehended on federal charges of public intoxication or driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled substance for an observational period of five (5) hours to (8) hours. Prisoners who have signed a waiver of immediate appearance and who do not appear to be in a condition that would be a danger to themselves or others are to be released upon their own recognizance.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that nothing in this Order shall be deemed to prohibit officers of authorized federal law enforcement agencies from taking any such prisoner forthwith before a United States Magistrate Judge of this district if it is deemed to be in the best interests of the safety and welfare of the prisoner and/or the public. Arresting officers shall instruct the Jailer whether the federal arrestee is to be released pursuant to this Order or held for an initial appearance with a Magistrate Judge.
