LIFTING STAY IMPOSED IN ALL CIVIL MATTERS
INVOLVING THE UNITED STATES AS A PARTY

By General Order No. 2019-1 entered on January 4, 2019, and the Amended General Order No. 2019-1 entered on January 17, 2019, the Court imposed a stay on all civil matters in which the United States was a party due to the lapse of congressional funding of the federal government, including the Department of Justice and the United States Attorney's Office for the Western District of Kentucky. On January 25, 2019, Congress passed a continuing resolution funding the federal government, which was subsequently signed into law by President Trump. As a result, the need for the stay has been abated.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay imposed by Amended General Order No. 2019-1 shall be lifted effective immediately.
