The Court having entered General Order 20-05 which, pursuant to section 15002(b)(1) of the CARES Act, authorizes the use of video conferencing for certain criminal case events during the course of the ongoing COVID-19 emergency, and in the interest of fostering greater public access to the Court's proceedings, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. All official court reporters for the Western District of Kentucky shall prepare a draft transcript of all change of plea and sentencing proceedings, in addition to any other proceedings that the presiding judge requests.
- 2. The Clerk of Court shall post all transcripts so prepared on the Court's website where they shall remain accessible to the general public for a period of thirty (30) days.
- 3. Such transcripts shall not be deemed an official transcript. Any individual requiring an official transcript must continue to pay the transcript fees prescribed by Joint General Order 2018-01.
- 4. This Order shall remain in effect for the same duration as General Order 20-05, unless terminated earlier.
