**GENERAL ORDER

On April 17, 2020, the Court entered General Order 20-09, extending the terms of service for all then-serving grand jury panels for an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration of their current terms. In light of the ongoing COVID-19 epidemic, the Court finds that impaneling new grand jurors cannot be done without seriously jeopardizing public health and safety, including the health and safety of the prospective grand jurors, counsel, and Court staff.

The Court further finds that it is, therefore, in the public interest to extend the term of service of all currently serving grand jury panels. Accordingly, and pursuant to Rule 6(g) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, the terms of service for all currently serving grand jury panels are **EXTENDED** through the following dates:
