The Court has reviewed and evaluated the attorney admission-related fees charged in the

Western District of Kentucky, concluding that both an increase in pro hac vice fees and the

imposition of a renewal fee for pro hac vice admissions are merited. Accordingly, and effective

August 1, 2023,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to Pursuant to LR 83.1 and LCrR 57.1, each

applicant for admission to the Bar of this Court shall pay to the Clerk the admission fee

prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, plus an additional fee of \$30.00 that

shall be deposited in the Court's Attorney Admission Fund.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to LR 83.2 and LCrR 57.2, each

applicant seeking permission to appear pro hac vice in a particular case shall pay the Clerk a fee

of \$150.00 per case, the entirely of which shall be deposited in the Court's Attorney Admission

Fund.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that if an attorney admitted to practice pro hac

vice in a particular case continues to appear in that case, the attorney shall pay a renewal fee of

\$150.00 each year until the case is concluded. The renewal fee shall be due on the one-year

anniversary of the attorney's original pro hac vice admission and shall be deposited in the Court's

Attorney Admission Fund. Any subsequent renewal fees shall be due in subsequent years on the

same calendar date. Failure to pay the renewal fee within thirty (30) days of the due date will

result in the attorney being suspended from appearing in any case in which he or she has been

admitted pro hac vice.

This General Order supersedes and vacates General Order 2016-02.
