ORDER

This matter is before the court on three motions of the plaintiff, Robert Jones, each of which request leave to amend his Complaint and add several defendants. The court has previously denied a similar motion filed by the plaintiff due to the deficiency of his attempt to amend his complaint. *See* Order, March 13, 1999. The plaintiff's present attempts are similarly deficient and "incomprehensible." Order, *supra* (citing *Prezzi v. Schelter*, 469 F.2d 691 (2d Cir. 1972); *Comsia v. Mangnone*, 815 F.2d 76 (6th Cir. 1987), unpubl., 1987 WL 35877).

For the reasons set forth herein and the court being otherwise sufficiently advised, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the motion of the plaintiff, Robert Jones, for leave to amend his Complaint is **DENIED**.
